RICHMOND, Va. (AP) - The head of the FBI office in Richmond says the agency is investigating the 2013 death of a man who was repeatedly shocked with stun guns by police. Adam Lee told The Associated Press that he personally went to the home of Linwood Lambert Jr.'s sister and told her the FBI is investigating.

RICHMOND, Va. (AP) - The Virginia General Assembly has speeding up funding for victims who were forcibly sterilized decades ago under a state program. The News & Advance reports lawmakers made \$400,000 available earlier than scheduled for the victims as part of its work on the state budget.

HENRICO, Va. (AP) - Authorities say no one was injured after a child's hoverboard caught fire in Henrico County. Multiple media outlets report the incident happened Wednesday evening. Fire officials say a boy was riding the hoverboard in the parking lot of an apartment complex when he fell off. Henrico Division of Fire says in a news release that when the child got back up, he noticed the hoverboard was smoking.
